6.Membership Report (John T)

Club membership currently stands at 478, this is an increase of 9 from 2021/22. This is the total membership for CTC Grampian (member of Cycling UK) of which about a fifth have ridden with the club during the year.

This year the club planned a total of 272 different runs. 37 rides were cancelled mainly due to inclement weather (21 in 2021/22) and 229 attendance sheets were received.
